## BYLAW NO. 210

## A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR DISCOUNTS AND PENALTIES RESPECTING CURRENT TAXES AND

## ARREARS OF TAXES

The Council of the Town of Ogema, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enact as follows:

- The Current Tax Levy shall be considered due on the first day of January in each year.
- 2. For Prompt payment of Current Levies the following discounts shall be allowed:
  - (a) payments received prior to the 1st day of September - a discount of 5% of the amount paid.
  - (b) payments received during the month of September - a discount of 4% of the amount paid
  - (c) payments received during the month of October a discount of 3% of the amount paid
  - (d) payments received during the month of November - a discount of 2% of the amount paid
- The penalty on tax arrears as provided in subsections (2) and (3) of Section 296 of the Urban Municipality Act, 1984, shall be one percent of the arrears of taxes for any taxes collected anytime during the month of January, and an additional one percent per month on taxes collected anytime during each month thereafter, until December 31st of each year.
- 4. Where the whole or any portion of the taxes remain unpaid on the expiration of any year succeeding the year in which the taxes were levied there shall be added thereto a penalty of twelve percent on December 31st of each year; and the amount added as a penalty shall form part of the arrears of taxes.
- 5. This Bylaw shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1995.
- 6. Bylaw No. 198 and Bylaw No. 199 passed on February 6th, 1990, is hereby repealed.
