

BYLAW NO. 152

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OGEMA WITH REGARDS TO THE OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES

The Council of the Town of Ogema, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions contained in subsection (1) of section 21 of the Snowmobile Act, 1973 it shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 12:00 P.M.

(a) on all streets except (i) Main Street between Saskatchewan Avenue and Railway Avenue;

(ii) Grid Road bounded by the  $W\frac{1}{2}$  21 and the  $E\frac{1}{2}$  22-7-22 W2

- except only for the purpose of crossing said Main Street and said Grid Road.
2. That nothing in this bylaw shall apply to any provincial highway.
3. That this bylaw repeals Bylaw No. 151.
