BYLAW NO. 239

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE LICENSING OF OCCUPANTS OF TRAILERS, MOBILE HOMES AND PORTABLE SHACKS.

The Council fo the Town of Ogema in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The occupant of every trailer, mobile home or portable shack used for residential purposes within the confines of the Town of Ogema shall within five days of the expiration of thirty days from the date of entry into the municipality register himself as the occupant of such trailer, mobile home or portable shack with the clerk of the municipality, and obtain a licence.
2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1, where the trailer, mobile home or portable shack is parked in a trailer park or camp licenced by the municipality, the occupant of such trailer, mobile home or portable shack shall register himself with the owner or operator of such park or camp and pay to him the prescribed fee for a licence.
3. The fee for a licence shall be \$180.00 per month.
4. Bylaw No. 200 is hereby repealed.
5. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any provision of this bylaw, shall be subject to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
