

BYLAW NO. 228

A BYLAW TO LICENCE TRANSIENT TRADERS

The Council of the Town of Ogema in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression "transient trader" shall have the meaning described to it by the Urban Municipality Act,
2. No person shall carry on any of the businesses set out in section 9 of this bylaw within the Town unless he possess a valid and subsisting licence for the purpose issued in accordance with the provisions of this bylaw.
3. The administrator of the Town is hereby authorized to issue a licence to any person carrying on business in the Town:
 - (A) which is not assessable by the Town for the purposes of business taxation in respect to that business; and
 - (B) who makes application for such licence stating specifically the nature of his business in the Town; and
 - (C) who has complied with the Auctioneers Act if the same applies or may apply in respect of the licence for which he has made application under this bylaw; and
 - (D) who tenders with his application the proper licence fee as herein provided for.
4. Subject to the right of the council to suspend or revoke the same, as provided by the Urban Municipality Act, every licence issued hereunder shall remain in force and effect until and including the thirty first day of December of the year of issue.
5. Where a licence is issued hereunder after July 1st of any year the fee payable under section 9 shall be reduced by 50%.
6. Every licence issued hereunder shall specifically state the kinds of services, goods or merchandise which the licensee is authorized to offer for sale or take orders for as the case may be and whether in the case of goods or merchandise, he may offer the same for sale by retail or by public auction or both, Such licence shall also state the restriction as set forth in section 7 hereof.
7. No person to whom a licence has been granted under this bylaw shall offer for sale services, goods or merchandise or solicit orders for future delivery of goods or merchandise within the Town:
 - a). Other than of a kind or kinds described in the licence; or
 - b). By any method except as authorizes therein, or
 - c). At any time during any period when shops within the Town offering for sale or taking orders for similar services, goods or merchandise are required by Town bylaw to be and remain closed.
8. Every person licenced under this bylaw shall, at all reasonable times, upon request of the Town Administrator, the Town constable or licence inspector, or any peace officer produce such licence for inspection purposes.

9. Subject to Section 5, the fee payable for a licence under this bylaw shall be as follows:

Artists	\$10.00	\$50.00
Carpet Cleaners	10.00	50.00
Fresh Produce Salesman	10.00	50.00
Furnace Cleaners	10.00	50.00
Gravestone and Cover Salesman	10.00	50.00
Photographer	10.00	50.00

10. Any person who violates any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties as proved in the general penalty bylaw of the Town.

11. Bylaw No. 185 is hereby repealed.
