BYLAW NO. 2021-04

A Bylaw of the Town of Ogema to Establish Election Procedures

Short Title

1. This bylaw may be cited as the "General Election Bylaw".

Purpose

2. The purpose of this bylaw is to:
- 2.1. Appoint a Returning Officer;
 - 2.2. Authorize the order of names on ballot; and
 - 2.3. Describe posting of notice requirements.

Appointment of Returning Officer

3. The Council of The Town of Ogema may appoint a person other than the Chief Administrative Officer as the Returning Officer.

Order of Names on Ballot

4. The order of names of candidates on the ballot will be arranged in order that the names are withdrawn from the receptacle pursuant to section 91 clause (2) (a) of the *Local Government Election Act*.

Posting of Notice

3. The Returning Officer may publish the notice:
- 3.1. In a conspicuous public location in the building that is the main office of the municipality;
 - 3.2. Distribute notice by mail; or
 - 3.3. In the form of an announcement on a radio or television station received in the area or on a website or by other electronic means.

Coming Into Force

19. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on September 14, 2021.
