

BYLAW NO. 169

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The Council of the Town of Ogema, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "public highway" means any street, lane or public highway within the Town, but does not include a provincial highway therein as designated pursuant to the provisions of the Highways Act;
 - (b) "vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Vehicles Act.
 - (c) "school zone" shall mean Mohnke Street.
2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 40 kilometers per hour on a public highway within the limits of the Town excepting the School Zone.
3. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 30 kilometers per hour within the the School Zone as defined above.
4. Section 2 and 3 shall not apply to the operators of fire engines or fire department apparatus or to vehicles being operated by law enforcement officers or to the operators of ambulances.
5. Any person guilty of an infraction of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the Town.
6. That Section 13 of Bylaw No. 72 be repealed.
