

**TOWN OF OGEMA  
BYLAW NO. 2022-03**

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OGEMA TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED  
FOR ENVIRONMENTAL FEE.**

The Council of the Town of Ogema, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The purpose of this Bylaw is to regulate the collection and disposal of recycling materials and for recycling service fees.
2. The fees mentioned in section 4 of this bylaw shall be known as environmental fees.
3. Council of the Town of Ogema shall review the environmental fees annually, and shall amend the fees from time to time as needed.
4. The environmental fees shall be set as follows \$10.00 per month for each household.
5. Residential properties will not have the option of opting out of the recycling program, and will be billed regardless of whether or not they use this service.
6. All residential properties shall be provided with one blue recycling bin.
7. Residential properties requiring additional recycling bins shall be billed accordingly.
8. Recycling collection will occur bi-weekly.
9. The environmental fee will be billed quarterly on the water and sewer utility billing and is due when rendered. A penalty of 2% per month will be charged on any unpaid amounts on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the month following the billing month.
10. In the case of commercial pickup, businesses may individually choose to opt out of the recycle program provided by the Town.
11. Town of Ogema fees will be prorated from the date of either opting out of or opting back into the Town's program. Large volume commercial users will not be permitted to participate in this service.
12. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final reading thereof.
